WHERE TO STAY

A luxurious alternative to staying in a hotel is to hire an apartment through the super-helpful Nice Pebbles (09.52.78.27.65, www.nice pebbles.com, €50-€200/night). Properties range from elegant, antique-dotted hideaways to slick. super-modern renovations with home cinema systems and immense walk-in showers. The pick of the bunch include the quirky Katja (a hip mix of modern design and flea market finds) and Vincent, an opulent Old Town pad (best feature: a magnificent Philippe Starck bath at the foot of the bed).

### Hi Hôtel

With its experimental living spaces in jellybean colours, this place remains the funkiest place to stay in Nice. The tiny rooftop pool has a lovely view, interiors are by up-and-coming designer Matali Crasset and there are DJ soirées on weekends.
